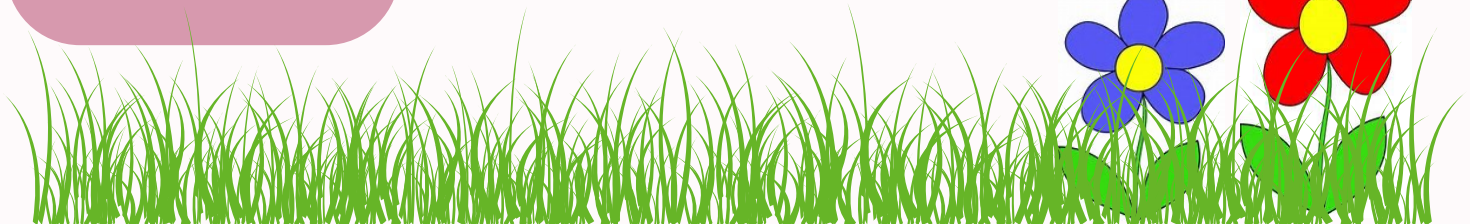
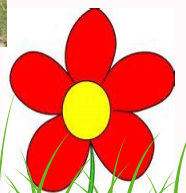

Hannah Sears— Hannah has been on work placement with us for over a year and is newly qualified.

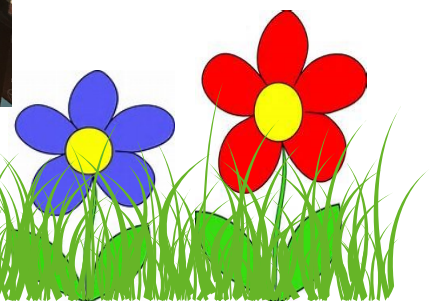
Carly Evans— Carly has worked for the company for over a year but in our DVLA nursery.

lots of activities:

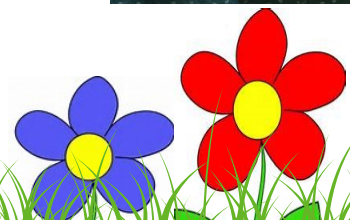
- shaving foam and seashells,

Paint– Colour of your choice.

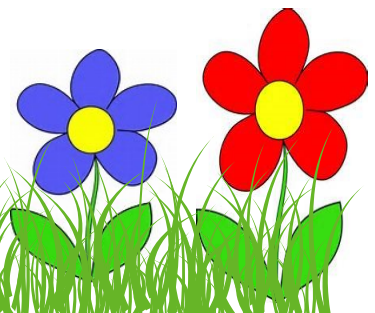
Cellotape bubble wrap to your child's feet. Put a long piece of paper across the floor indoors or outdoors and let your child stomp up and down creating different patterns.
