Section Information

Under 2's

Our under 2's have been learning about recognising numbers and counting, they have counted everything you can imagine, wheels, cars, blocks and so on. They are so clever! The under 2's have also been doing Christmas craft and preparing for their new topic in January of colours.

Toddlers

The toddlers have been learning about all different kinds of transport, they have been learning about how different vehicles move around and mark making with different modes of transport too. The toddlers have also been learning about independence and are being encouraged and helped by staff to collect their own coats and meals, and also to scrape their own plates at the end of meals times and pour their own drinks, well done toddlers, you are doing a great job.

Pre-School

Pre-school has recently got a mud kitchen for our preschoolers to play around in outside. They have also painted lovely bird houses to watch all the birds come and go. This term's topic is all about people who help us. The pre-school children have been doing observational drawings of fire engines. This month, the children are drawing their own Christmas pictures on the computer, how clever!

Singleton's famous Chocolate Orange sponge and Custard

This is a big favourite with all of our children, why not try it at home.....

Ingredients for cake 6oz self raising flour 2oz cocoa powder 8oz margarine 4 eggs 6oz sugar 2 oranges 3 tbsp. sugar

Ingredients for <u>custard</u>

1 cup of milk ½ cup of cream 2 egg yolks 1 tsp cornflour ½ vanilla pod

Method for cake

Preheat oven to 170°C, mix all ingredients, except oranges and 3 tbsp. sugar, together in a bowl. Place in a cake tine in the oven for 20-25 minutes. Whilst cake is baking, squeeze the juice from the oranges and add the sugar to a saucepan. Let this simmer until it forms a syrup. Once the cake is baked, prick the top with several holes and pour the syrup into the cake.

Method for custard

Add milk & cream to a saucepan. Split the vanilla pod in half lengthways and scrape out the seeds. Add to saucepan along with the pod. Bring milk mixture to almost boiling in a separate bowl, whisk eggs and corn flour to combine while whisking, slowly add milk mixture to the eggs Return the mixture to the saucepan and cook on low heat while continuously stirring until the custard thickens. Once ready it should coat the back of the spoon.
