



As a Nursery we celebrated Teddy Bears Picnic day, where all the children had the opportunity to bring in their favourite teddy from home to join in on our fun and tasty picnic. While out in the garden the children enjoyed the teddy bears picnic story and thoroughly entertained by the activities they took part in, such as creating bear masks and making their own jam Sandwiches.



A favourite choice on our lunch time menu to all the children is our homemade soup.

This is for about roughly 12 children! Fancy trying this at home the ingredients are;

- 2 tbsp. olive oil
- 1 onion chopped
- 1 garlic clove, peeled and crushed
- 2 medium carrots cut into small chunks
- 100g of butternut squash, peeled and diced
- 100g of sweet potato, peeled and diced
- 2 tubs of passata
- 700ml vegetable stock

Method

- 1) Heat the vegetable oil in a fairly large pan, add the onion and chopped vegetables.
- Pour over the vegetable stock and the passata and then cover and cook gently, stirring occasionally for 20 minutes or until the vegetables are soft.
- 3) Simmer for 15 minutes, then blitz in a food processor.
