Winter Clothing Reminder

As the weather gets colder, please make sure your child comes to nursery with:

- A warm coat
- Hat and gloves
- Wellies if it's wet

We go outside in all weathers, so having the right clothing helps children stay comfortable and enjoy their play.

Warm Apple & Cinnamon Oat Cups

These soft, lightly sweet oat cups are perfect for breakfast, snacks, or lunchboxes. They're naturally sweetened, full of fibre, and easy for little hands to help make.

Ingredients

- 2 cups rolled oats
- 1 cup milk (dairy or non-dairy)
- 1 egg (or 1 mashed banana as an egg-free option)
- 1 apple, grated
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 tablespoon honey or maple syrup (optional, avoid honey for under-1s)
- A handful of raisins or chopped dried fruit (optional)

Instructions

1. Preheat your oven to **180°C** and line a muffin tray with cases.
2. In a bowl, mix the oats, cinnamon, and raisins.
3. Add the milk, egg (or mashed banana), grated apple, and honey/maple syrup.
4. Stir everything together until the mixture is thick and well combined.
5. Spoon into muffin cases and gently press down with the back of a spoon.
6. Bake for **20–25 minutes** until firm and lightly golden.
7. Allow to cool slightly before enjoying.
