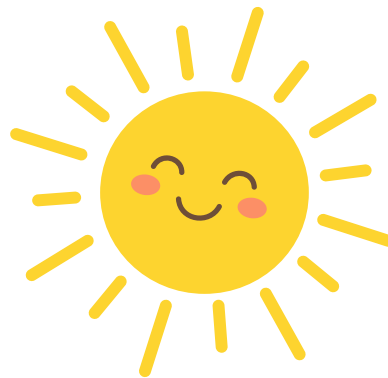


Welcome Joleen...

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Summer Harvest Galette

You need: pastry, any fruit or vegetables, cheese, olive oil, herbs

Steps:

1. Heat oven to 200°C (180°C fan).
2. Put pastry on tray, add cheese.
3. Children arrange fruit/veg on top.
4. Season, drizzle oil, fold edges in.
5. Bake 25–30 mins until golden.

Serve with salad.
