We would like to thank you all for your continued support during this unprecedented time.

As you are aware the children and staff temperatures are being taken before entry to nursery. If your child has a temperature of 37.8 or above they will be unable to attend until they are 48 hours clear of a fever without any medication. If your child is unwell please do not bring them to the nursery, stay at home and contact your nursery manager for advice.

BRRR, it's cold outside! Please be sure to send your child in with appropriate coats, hats and welly boots as we will continue to go outside as the weather allows us to! Please make sure all items of clothing are labelled.

Trousers/ leggings, socks/ tights and underwear if Potty training.
