Message from Sam & team

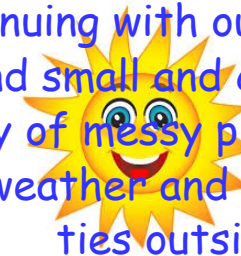
During the hot weather we have been doing lots of water play to keep cool.
