The current trend (which is actually an old one, Vygotsky, Píaget, et al) is that children learn best through play, using their imagination and exploring for themselves.

Most of the latest research says that specific topics should be abandoned as they narrow the children's experience and learning. Construction area, mark making, home corner etc. Should be at a low level for easy access and the children should be able to play with whatever they like and where their imagination takes them



The role of the adult is to observe, join in and scaffold the play when they can see potential areas for learning.
