# News from the sections....

#### <u>under 2's</u>

The children in our under 2's have enjoyed exploring the outdoor area in the wet weather. We have put on our wetsuits and wellies and have thoroughly enjoyed making a splash in the puddles.

We have also spent a great deal of time working on our mindfulness, and having regular yoga sessions. The children have really enjoyed this and have taken part well. We use these sessions to calm our minds and relax,

something very important during our days full of activities!

Other celebrations have included Valentines Day, St David's Day and World Book Day.

As we continue into the spring months, we will continue to spend a great deal of our time outdoors. We would like to please remind all parents and guardians that we require spare, suitable clothing to change.

### Pre-school & Playscheme

The preschool children have spent a great deal of time doing physical activities such as music and movement sessions and outdoor play. The children have particularly enjoyed musical statues.

We have also enjoyed taking time to learn about friendships, and doing activities related to this. These activities have included making friendship trees, a friendship pie in the tuff spot and looking at friendship books!
