Nursery Winter Recipe

LEEK AND POTATO SOUP

INGREDIENTS

1 tbsp vegetable oil 1 onion, sliced 225g/8oz potatoes, cubed 2 medium leeks, sliced 1.2 litres/2 pints vegetable stock 150ml/5fl oz double cream or crème fraîche salt and freshly ground black pepper

METHOD

Heat the oil in a large pan and add the onions, potatoes and leeks. Cook for 3-4 minutes until starting to soften.

Add the vegetable stock and bring to the boil. Season well and simmer until the vegetables are tender.
