# What is going on at Singleton

### <u>Under 2's</u>

The under 2's will be busy exploring summer but taking part in sand, water, and messy play activities.

They will also be continuing with their Alice Sharp adventure using real objects to explore the world around us.

They will also be spending lots of time in the garden taking part in a range of physical activities using play equipment, music, and bubbles.



### Toddlers

#### <u>Alí's Summer Specíal</u>

#### Sweet and Sour Chicken (serves 4)

- 1 Tbsp Vegetable oil
- 1 oníon
- з garlíc cloves
- 2 Tsp Gínger puree
- 4 chícken breasts
- 2 peppers, deseeded and chopped
- 1 carrot
- 1 drained can of pineapple in natural juice

#### <u>Sauce</u>

- 1 tsp cornflour
- 1 tbsp white wine vinegar
- 1 tbsp low sodium soy sauce
- Half cup of juice from the can of pineapples
- 1 tbsp tomato puree (paste)

#### <u>Method</u>

- 1. Cook chicken, onion, and garlic
- 2. Add bell peppers, carrots, and ginger puree, cook until soft
- 3. Make the sauce and add to vegetables with pineapple chunks
- 4. Leave to simmer for 30 minutes
- 5. Serve with rice
