We will also be continuing our Adventure with Alice as the children really enjoyed exploring, all different types of keys, using our senses to explore. We can't wait to start on the next adventure.





Toddlers

Over the coming months we are starting our new topic 'All about me' where we will be learning about our families and friends by doing activities such as looking at our facial features and painting a portrait, sharing family photos and mak-

ing our own houses.





Before moving on to learn about all the arctic animals in their habitats where we will be doing ice cube play with the animals, matching animals, counting using the animals as well as creative activities such as painting and making our favourite

animal.





Pre-school

In pre school we have been doing lots of science experiments using our senses. The Pre schoolers have been investigating to see what different reactions can be made from the science experiments. One of the pre schoolers favourite experiment was the fizzing tuff spot which they were mesmerised

by. The pre school children also have been busy bees gardening in the pre school garden. We have currently planted tomato's which we are all excited to see how they would grow.





Coming up we are learning about autumn and winter. We will be exploring through a range of activities including leaf modelling where autumn animals

would be created out of leaves and we will be learning why leaves fall from the trees. For winter, the pre school children will be pretending they are penguins, ice painting and ice play will be explored



and experimented with.

Ali's Nursery Winter special

1 tbsp olive oil

1 onions, diced

1 bell peppers, thinly

2 tsp chopped garlic

250g long grain rice

350ml chicken stock

1 tbsp Cajun seasoning

2 cans of chopped tomato

4 chicken breasts, chopped

Feeds Family of 4

sliced

Ingredients



Chicken Jambalaya

Method

- Heat 1 tbsp olive oil in a large <u>frying pan</u> with a lid and brown 2 chopped chicken breasts for 5-8 mins until golden.
- Remove and set aside. Tip in the diced onion and cook for 3-4 mins until soft.



Add your thinly sliced peppers, crushed garlic cloves, Cajun seasoning, and cook for 5-10 mins more.

Stir the chicken back in with the long grain rice, add the can of tomatoes and chicken stock. Cover and simmer for 20-25 mins until the rice is tender and cooked.
