Under 2's

We would like to welcome all the new children to the under 2's section. In the under 2's we have been focussing on Summer activities such as sand and water play with buckets and spades, a Teddy bears picnic out in our garden and we even went on a walk in the prams to the park. The children really enjoyed taking in all the scenery and feeding the ducks.

We have been very lucky with all the beautiful weather we have had enabling us to take our activities out side and enjoy the weather. Our next topics will be based on Autumn books such as "that's not my squirrel" and "that's not my fox" where we will carry out lots of sensory activities that will enhance their development.

Toddlers

We are looking forward to having Jess back from maternity leave.

Through the Summer our topic was all creatures great and small where we have made cd snails, Had a visit from Tillies tortoise and hatched caterpillars into butterflies.

Our next topic is going to be all about Marvellous me/Autumn. We are going to be going on an Autumn walk to explore our surroundings and collect natural resources for our Autumn topic and activities. We will be looking for coloured leaves to make prints and rubbings and conkers to explore and create marks. We will also be exploring our senses during marvellous me through a range of fine and gross motor activities.



Pre-school

Our current theme is 'All creatures great and small'. We have recently been on a bug hunt in the garden to see what we could find and made insect paintings to reflect our findings, we have also been encouraging the children to be independent by getting them to apply their own sun cream to go in the garden and putting on their own sun hat. Our next topic is on the move. We will be learning about different forms of transport and how they move. We will be making a variety of vehicles from different materials and listening to the sounds they make.



Play scheme

Throughout the Summer we have enjoyed a variety of topics and activities which included friendship week where we made cards, poems and bracelets for our friends, Around the world where we tickled our taste buds and tried foods from different countries like Indian poppadum and chutney and Welsh cakes, and pirate & princess week where we made rice crispy pirates and princess crown snacks, walked the plank with lots of fun out door activities and finished the week with a pirate and princess themed party where the children got to join in with games and dress up.

In the next playscheme the children will be getting creative with our topic Autumn. We will be making leaf models out of natural materials, leaf printing and going on a nature walk. As it is Halloween on the Thursday we will have a Halloween party for the children where they can make lots of fun spooky things, dress up and eat scrumptious party food.
