## **Spring flowers**

Here is an activity you can try at home to keep the little ones busy. All you need is paint and a paint brush, scissors, tissue paper and pipe cleaners and your away to go.

#### **Recipe**

Serves 16 children Prep time- 15 mins Cook time- 35 mins

Apple and sultana sponge



Ingredients: 3 eating apples, peeled and grated 125g melted butter 150g self-raising flour 120g caster sugar 2 tbsp soft brown sugar 50g sultanas ½ tsp ground cinnamon 3 eggs Method:

1 Grease a 900g loaf tin, measuring about 22 x 12cm and line the base with baking parchment. Preheat the oven to 180°C/Gas 4. 2 Put all the ingredients in a mixing bowl and beat with a wooden spoon to make a smooth batter. 3 Spoon the mixture into the prepared loaf tin and bake in the oven for 30-35 minutes or until a skewer inserted into the middle of the cake comes out clean. Remove the cake from the tin and leave it to cool on a wire rack
